## State Testing for Grades 3 & 4

Students in grades 3 and 4 will be taking mandatory state tests in the areas of Math and Reading in April. We will begin with 3rd grade Reading on April 10th, followed by 4th grade on April 17th. Math will then take place the week of the 23rd for both grade levels. These tests are all given online. It is extremely important that your child be present for testing.
