## TRACKING OUR WILDLY IMPORTANT GOALS (WIGS)

Our school is tracking some Wildly Important Goals (WIGS) in order to ensure school-wide success. These areas are being tracked at the individual student level, class level and school level so we can see how our reading strategies, behavior and attendance come together to help us be successful in school.

### BEHAVIOR

We ask our students to demonstrate good leadership though their daily behavior and interactions with others. The 9 last weeks we have been running between 84%-89%! Our goal is 85%! Nice job!

### ATTENDANCE

We would like your child to be at school EVERY day to do their best learning! Our attendance has been running between 93-97%. The average was 95% but our goal is 97%.

### READING SKILLS

We had 87% of students show growth on their grade level reading indicators. We are continuously striving for this number to be 100%! Literacy is a life skill which we work on with all students daily.
