# <u>LEAD & ACHIEVE</u> <u>SCHOOL-WIDE</u> <u>GOALS</u>

To ensure high expectations for all students, we are running our Lead and Achieve goals schoolwide again this year.

Our Lead Goal has to do with behavior. We expect students to strive for green behavior according to our behavior wheel system) each day, but understand that yellow is okay, as we all may need a reminder now and then. Our school-wide goal is that all students will be on Green/Yellow at least 80% of the time. So far we have been running at 87-90% each week!

Our Achieve Goal has to do with Reading Achievement. We are looking for our students to meet their reading goals measured by completion of reading homework in grades K-1 and the passage of AR quizzes in grades 2-4. Our goal is to have 80% of student meeting this benchmark each week. Currently we have been running between 67-77% we are working to hit that 80%.
