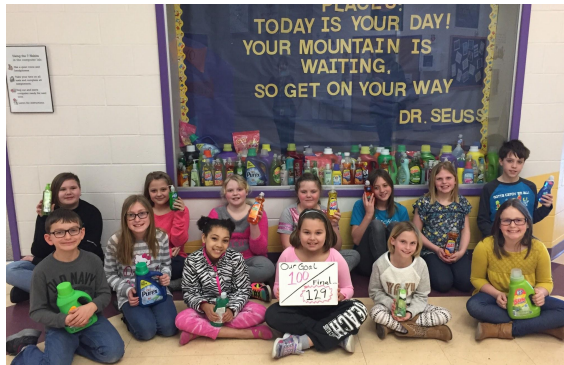

TRACKING OUR WILDLY IMPORTANT GOALS (WIGS)

Our school is tracking some Wildly Important Goals (WIGS) in order to ensure school-wide success. These areas are being tracked at the individual student level, class level and school level so we can see how our reading strategies, behavior and attendance come together to help us be successful in school.

BEHAVIOR

March behaviors were more steady especially during the second half of the grading period where we met or exceeded our goal for nearly 5 weeks straight!

ATTENDANCE

Attendance has been rebounding and we have seen several weeks between 94-96%. We are hopeful that the last grading period brings good health to our building and we can get back up to our goal of 97% attendance.

READING SKILLS
