This year the test will be given in an online format to all students. This is new for our district and we are busily working to help students be confident in their technology skills. Students have had a great deal of practice with online tests in the classroom setting.

The test will be given on the following schedule:

March 13-14 3rd grade ELA

March 15-16 4th grade ELA

April 10-11 3rd grade Math

April 12-13 4th grade Math

April 18th 4th grade Social Studies

Please be sure that your student is in attendance during these weeks.

Each test is given in 2 parts. ELA and Math will be given over 2 days and Social Studies will be done in AM/PM session.
