



Accelerated Reader AR

Central Elementary is continuing the **Accelerated Reader** program to help our students track their reading progress in Grades 1-4.

After reading an AR book, students complete a computerized reading comprehension quiz over the book. Students have a reading goal based on a number of points for each grading period. Every time a student takes a quiz and earns an 80% or better, he/she receives an AR ticket for a drawing on Monday morning which earns them the Golden Apple for the week. When students reach their AR goal for the grading period, they earn a prize!

Students who earn 200% of their goal will have a special event at the end of the grading period.

Students are provided with silent reading time at school. Earning AR points is one way to jump-start children into reading for pleasure.

You can help your child by encouraging him/her to read AR books to you at home. Books are color coded based on the reading level of your child. AR books are available in our library at school as well as the Logan Hocking Library on Main Street.

A computer print out of your child's progress towards his/her AR goal can be requested through your child's classroom teacher. AR progress will be noted on grade cards.
