**School Wide Goals**  
All students will Synergize to meet our two school wide goals. Our goals include having 95% attendance every week which include tardies and leaving early from school. Our second school wide goal is for 90% of our students to meet their LEAD goal. Students will track these two school wide goals in their yellow LEAD folder. This folder will come home each evening. Please discuss your child's success each day. A monthly celebration will be held for students who earn both 95% attendance for the month and 90% LEAD status.

**Wildly Important Goals**  
Students will set Wildly Important Goals (W.I.G.s) each grading period. Students will begin the year setting an AR and Math fact goal. Goals will change based on student success. Students will also list three strategies to help reach their goal while keeping score of how often they implement these strategies. We will set our first set of W.I.Gs in September. W.I.Gs will be kept in the yellow LEAD folder so that parents can review their child's progress nightly.

Every student will have a Leadership Notebook at school to keep their completed W.I.Gs, evidence of Leadership Roles, and Victories. Students will share their notebooks with peers and teachers as well as their parents.

Our goal is to have parent events throughout the school year so that students can share their Leadership Notebooks and parents can learn more about our leadership culture.

On **DEAL** days, students will participate in activities from their LEAD activity book to help us improve our leadership habits.

Throughout the year students who ride the bus will Synergize with one another to be Bus Card Free. Students will track how many days their bus is Bus Card Free. Rewards for the most days in a row, most Bus Card Free days in all, and students who are Bus Card Free will occur periodically throughout the school year. Students will write ways to stay Bus Card Free on the Lotus diagram hanging in the hallway.
