

OTHER APPROVED ACTIVITIES FOR EARNING CEU CREDIT

The following is a list of options that you may use to earn CEU credit.

Uncapped Areas: (Total CEU's based on documented contact hours.)

- Conferences (Regional/ State/ National)
- Post graduate offerings
- VCR / Internet Courses
- Workshop Participation
- Independent Study Pre-approved by LPDC
- Successful Completion of the National Board Certification Process (36 CEU's)

Capped Areas: No more than a total of 6 CEUs needed to renew a certificate/license may come from capped areas. These areas are capped at 2 CEUs per experience, and no individual area may exceed 1/6 of the total allowable CEUs during a renewal. A capped activity document form (page 15) must be completed for each of the following for post/final approval.

- Academic Presentations (ie. In service/ community/ parent presentations, workshop presenter preparation time)
- Independent Technology Training
- Community Service in Hocking County
- Curriculum Development
- Developing Assessment/ Job Related Programs
- Extracurricular that is related to field of study
- Externships/ Related Work Experiences (ie. Observations/ Shadowing)
- Professional Association Leadership Roles (ie. Regional/ State/ National)
- Professional Honors (ie. Martha Holden Jennings Lecture Series)
- Independent Professional Readings
- Cultural experiences related to field of study
- Publishing and Professional Exhibitions
- Safety Training (ie. CPR/ First Aid)
- Supervisor for Interns (ie. Student teacher, psych./ guidance/ principal/ mentors)
- Committees
- Grants
- Observations

This is not an exclusive list. Additional activities may be suggested to the LPDC for preapproval.

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
