

Dear Freshmen Parents,

We are excited to announce that this year's Freshman Valentine's Day Dance will be held on Saturday, February 6th from 8:00-10:00 p.m. in the high school cafeteria.

TICKETS: Tickets will cost \$10.00 each. This increase is due to an effort to reduce the number of merchandise-selling fundraisers in our district. There was not a freshman fundraiser this year. Instead, we are charging \$5.00 more per ticket. Tickets will be sold in the cafeteria during all lunch periods on Thursday Feb. 4th and Friday Feb. 5th. Admission to the dance will require a ticket (we won't be selling them the night of the dance).

WHAT TO WEAR: Formal or evening casual (dress slacks and a tie are fine for evening casual). When picking out your outfit, please remember that once students enter the dance, they won't be allowed to leave and come back, even to change.

COAT CHECK: The coat check-room will be located in Mrs. Wolfinger's room, #307. Coats, bags, and shoes may be checked in at no charge. **Parents who are willing to volunteer to run the coat check during the dance - please send a note to Mrs. Corby. We need at least 3-4 parents PLEASE.**

WHO MAY ATTEND: The dance is for freshman students from Logan High School. Students in grades 10, 11, or 12 from Logan High School or students from other schools who wish to accompany a freshman to the dance will need special permission from Mr. Janey.

PICTURES: There will be a photographer at the dance to take portraits that will include a background of the dance theme. Portrait order forms will be available at the ticket sales table. Money and forms will be due to the photographer at the dance.

ENTRANCE: Students who wish to be on TV-2 should enter through the main doors to the school and then follow the directions for the entrance walk. Parents should line up along the first floor main hallway to watch. The TV-2 cameras will be at the end of the walk, just before the dance entrance.

*****HELP NEEDED:** Set up will take place on Friday, February 5th. Clean up will start Saturday night at 10:05 p.m. We **really need parents to help with this** - last year we were finished at 11 pm, so it's only an hour commitment, if that. Students are not responsible for helping clean up.

SNOW DATE: The tentative make-up date for the dance is Saturday, February 20th. If you are renting a vehicle or tuxedo, make sure that this date will work if needed.
