Remember that you should call the office by **3pm** or send a note if you need your child prior to office pick up at 3:50. Last minute calls make dismissal more difficult!

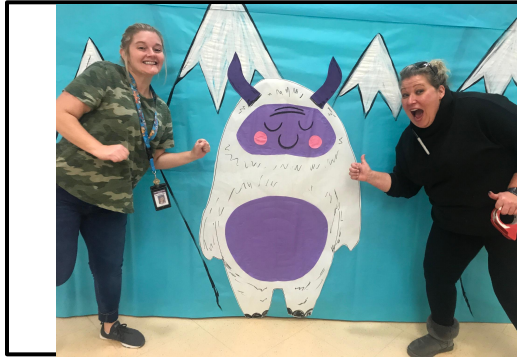
Inclement

HABIT HINT

Habit # 5- Seek First to Understand, Then to be Understood.
When talking with others, we often listen with the intent to respond, rather than the intent to understand. Use the rule to listen twice as much as you speak. We also use this habit in reminding students to follow oral directions by being good Habit #5 listeners.

WILDLY IMPORTANT GOALS (WIGS)

Our school is tracking some Wildly Important Goals (WIGS) in order to ensure school-wide success. These areas are being tracked at the individual student level, class level and school level so we can see how our reading strategies, behavior and attendance come together to help us be successful in school.

BEHAVIOR

Our WIG for behavior is to have students displaying green or yellow behavior 85% of the time. We have been experiencing some great fluctuation in our behavior as of late. It is important that all students use Habit #1- Be Proactive!

ATTENDANCE

Our WIG for attendance is for our school to have 95% attendance each week. We are still running into issues with attendance and few days where classes have 100% attendance. Students must be present to learn to the best of their ability.

READING SKILLS

Our WIG for Reading is that 100% of K-4 student will show growth each 9 weeks on their reading skills indicators. Our first grading period percentage was 87%! Not a bad start, but we are striving for 100%!
