Please send your child with a coat, hat and gloves so they can enjoy recess on cooler days. Our school has extras for emergencies, but really need students to come prepared.

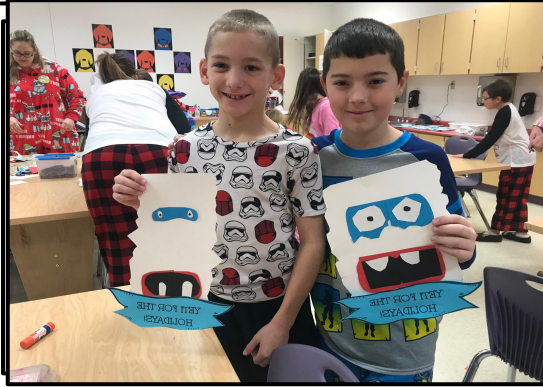
### **Inclement**

### **WILDLY IMPORTANT GOALS (WIGS)**

Our school is tracking some Wildly Important Goals (WIGS) in order to ensure school-wide success. These areas are being tracked at the individual student level, class level and school level so we can see how our reading strategies, behavior and attendance come together to help us be successful in school.

#### **BEHAVIOR**

Our WIG for behavior is to have students displaying green or yellow behavior 85% of the time. Our overall average for the grading period was 85%. We are starting the new semester with reminders on being proactive to meet our goal.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

Our WIG for attendance is for our school to have 95% attendance each week. Our average for the 9 weeks was 96%. We hope to keep students healthy enough to continue to meet our goal during the next 9 weeks.

#### **READING SKILLS**

Our WIG for Reading is that 100% of K-4 student will show growth each 9 weeks on their reading skills indicators. We are currently calculating our latest average and will share it in next month's update.
