HABIT HINT

Habit # 2 is Begin With the End in Mind. This means having a plan and understanding of what your expected outcome or goal is. For example, with our student led conferences, the end in mind is that the students can communicate effectively about their learning by sharing with their parents.

WILDLY IMPORTANT GOALS (WIGS)

Our school is tracking some Wildly Important Goals (WIGS) in order to ensure school-wide success. These areas are being tracked at the individual student level, class level and school level so we can see how our reading strategies, behavior and attendance come together to help us be successful in school.

BEHAVIOR

Our WIG for behavior is to have students displaying green or yellow behavior 85% of the time. Our average for the first grading period was 85%. We hope to keep growing in behavior to see if we can exceed our goal!

ATTENDANCE

Our WIG for attendance is for our school to have 95% attendance each week.. Our average for the first 9 weeks was 95%, but most classes had only a few days with everyone present. Students learn best when at school everyday!

READING SKILLS

Our WIG for Reading is that 100% of K-4 student will show growth each 9 weeks on their reading skills indicators. Calculations are being run for the first grading period.
